

- 2. Being part of a Knitting/Crochet Circle at St. Augustine's of Canterbury Episcopal Church (475 43rd Ave., Vero Beach)
- 3. Hygiene Packet Packing at United against Poverty (1400 27th St., Vero Beach)
- 4. Working at the Shining Lights Garden (7275 49th St., Vero Beach)

The Knitting and Crochet Circle at St. Augustine's will be making squares of knitting or crochet that will be attached together to make shawls or blankets or just used as mini lovies. Others will be making a small animal/creature that could go to a child or person who needs a soft pick-me-up. Both projects would be simple, quick and could be shared with different groups. You can come help create or come learn so you can do these craft acts to help someone in the future.

The four candates will be formally submitted to the General Convention during a joint session on June 25, a day before the House of

Bishops is scheduled to elect the 28th presiding bishop.




Altar Flowers
