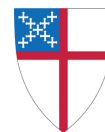

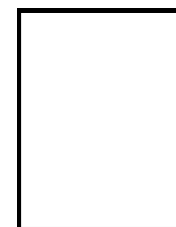


Lay Eucharistic Ministers
