St. Augustine's donated a total of 2006 pounds of food to the Salvation Army food pantry here in Vero Beach, in the first quarter of 2024!







- 2. Being part of a Knitting/Crochet Circle at St. Augustine's of Canterbury Episcopal Church (475 43rd Ave., Vero Beach)
- 3. Hygiene Packet Packing at United against Poverty (1400 27th St., Vero Beach)
- 4. Working at the Shining Light Garden (7275 49th St., Vero Beach)

The Knitting and Crochet Circle at St. Augustine's will be making squares of knitting or crochet that will be attached together to make shawls or blankets or just used as mini lovies. Others will be making a small animal/creature that could go to a child or person who needs a soft pick-me-up. Both projects would be simple, quick and could be shared with different groups. You can come help create or come learn so you can do these craft acts to help someone in the future.
